

# “LALAGE”

The English Representative  
for the Olympic Games

THESE unusual photographs give an extraordinarily fine impression of the lines of “Lalage,” Messrs. Belville, Boardman and Leaf’s new 6-metre, which has been chosen to represent England in the coming Olympic Games, the yacht-racing section of which takes place at Heligoland in August.

Her lines are nicely full and show that she has plenty of power, though without that excessive fullness which is so detrimental to light weather work. Her design, which is completely free from the eccentricities to which so many naval architects nowadays fall a victim when drawing the lines of small racers, reveals a nice appreciation of the ideals which should be aimed at for successful 6-metre racing.

In the water, “Lalage” handles quickly and sweetly, and her novel arrangement of three cockpits and a fore hatch make the handling of sails and running gear a comparatively simple matter. She should give a very good account of herself in the Olympic races.
